

SEMAGLUTIDE/CYANACOBALAMIN SUBCUTANEOUS INJECTION



What This Medication Is For

Semaglutide/Cyanacobalamin is a compounded injection used to support blood sugar control and weight management.

Semaglutide helps regulate blood sugar and reduce appetite, while cyanacobalamin (vitamin B12) supports energy, brain health, and red blood cell production.

How To Take This Medication

This medication is given once weekly by subcutaneous injection (under the skin) using a pre-filled syringe. Dosing typically starts low and increases as directed by your provider.

Instructions for Use

- Wash hands before and after use
- Clean injection site with alcohol
- Inject into thigh, abdomen (2 inches from navel), or upper arm
- Rotate injection sites weekly
- Inject full syringe and dispose in sharps container

Missed Dose

Take as soon as remembered unless within 48 hours of next dose. Do not double dose. If two doses are missed, contact your provider.

Possible Side Effects

- Nausea or upset stomach
- Constipation or diarrhea
- Bloating or gas
- Injection site reactions (redness, itching, swelling)
- Low blood sugar (dizziness, sweating, confusion, shaking, rapid heartbeat)

Contact your healthcare provider immediately if you experience symptoms of low blood sugar or an allergic reaction.

Storage

- Store refrigerated
- Do not freeze
- May be stored refrigerated for up to 56 days

Allow medication to reach room temperature before injection to help reduce discomfort.

General Guidance

- Do not use if allergic to semaglutide or cyanacobalamin
- Do not use if you or a family member has a history of thyroid cancer
- Keep out of reach of children and pets
- Do not share this medication
- Dispose of used syringes properly

If you believe an overdose has occurred, contact Poison Control or seek medical attention immediately.
